Frequent Hand Washing Mandated

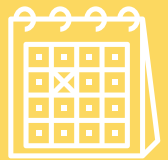


Daily Disinfecting of ALL School Spaces

## Individualized School Supplies

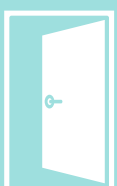
Shared use of supplies can spread germs. All student belongings need to be clearly labelled.



All extra-curricular clubs and sports cancelled for now.

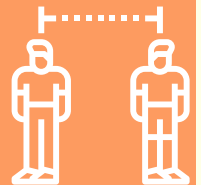
## What Will Never Change?

Specified Entrances & Exits, Staggered Transitions, and Designated Line Ups for Physical Distancing
