Parent-Teacher-Student Conference

Our virtual Parent-Teacher-Student conferences will take place on Thursday, November 19th, 2020 (Wednesday, November 18th for our Kindergarten

A families). No school for students on their conference day. Due to COVID-19 conferences will be via Google Meets. It would be



preferable that students be present during your 12minute (3 minutes needed for transitions) conference, however we understand that this may not be possible for all families. You will receive a link to sign-up for a conference time on November 8th via email. Should a Google Meet conference not be possible for your family, please arrange a phone conference with the classroom teacher. We have moved to a new online system called SchoolInterviews.ca, a Canadian company that provides much better value for our community. You will receive information from the classroom teachers prior to the conference in preparation for discussing your child(ren)'s progress and success at École Massey.

Safety Guidelines:

We are very thankful that as of this date, we have not had a positive case of COVID-19 at École Massey. The following are some of the many guidelines followed at École Massey:

- 1. Students remain in their cohorts at all times.
- 2. Teachers keep track of small group instruction on a daily basis.
- 3. Class seating plans are set and students must remain in their seats with front facing instruction, even during lunchtime.
- 4. Students use their own materials and are not to share with other classmates.
- 5. Any shared classroom materials are sanitized using Vital Oxide.
- 6. Students transported by bus have assigned seating and must remain in their seats. Our bus supervisors check buses on a regular basis.
- 7. Students who are ill with COVID-19 symptoms wait in the isolation rooms until their parents/guardians arrive to meet them outside the front door. Record of use kept if needed by SHA.
- 8. Continued use of Vital Oxide multiple times daily in all areas of the school.
- 9. Social distanced waiting lines for washrooms and office identified with floor signage.
- 10. Our gym is open to higher grades with guidelines for safety and sanitizing. We will continue to introduce lower grades gradually.
- 11. Students and staff allowed in building only. Parent early pick-ups or drop-offs done outside the front door. Call when you arrive.

Band Program:



Students in grades 6, 7 & 8 are now receiving band instruction once a week from our band teachers Mrs. Anderson and Mr. Wilkinson. A maximum of 4

students from the same cohorts attend a 30-minute session while maintaining social distancing and following guidelines such as bell covers, special masks and pads for cleaning of instruments. A 20-minute gap between sessions is necessary in order to sanitize the space and items used with Vital Oxide.

Equipment from home:

In order to maintain student and staff safety, we ask that students do not bring equipment such as footballs, basketball, toboggans, etc. to school. We are in the process of purchasing multiple items for each classroom so that we can maintain the directives from SHA and keep our classroom cohorts safe. Access to materials will be available

to students from their own classrooms. The type of equipment purchased include skipping ropes, basketballs, footballs, soccer balls, scoops, etc. for the recess break at lunchtime and during class



scheduled physical education/movement breaks. These materials will be sanitized after every use using Vital Oxide and stored in the individual classrooms.

Our SCC had their AGM on Oct. 13th via ZOOM with very encouraging attendance. At this time, members were either elected or appointed to positions available on the executive and SCC. All are welcome to attend the meetings. The next meeting will occur virtually via ZOOM again on Tuesday, November 03, 2020.
